



DINE FOR DOLLARS FUNDRAISER GUIDELINES

Poblano Grill is proud to support the communities in which we operate. When evaluating partners, ideal organizations are those that strengthen families, promote a safe, nurturing environment for children and youth and emphasize student academic achievement. Poblano Grill donations are NOT intended to be used by individuals or groups collecting personal or corporate profit or causes that are in contrast to our family-based values.

How Poblano Grill DINE FOR DOLLARS Works:

- Each organization works with Poblano Grill to reserve a date for their Dine for Dollars event. The organization may only select one day. Dine for Dollars will be scheduled based on availability and are not available on most holidays.
- Dine for Dollars events held on Mondays or Tuesdays only.
- 10% of net food purchases will be donated to the organization from 4pm-close.
- Guest dining-in or carrying-out for the Dine for Dollars fundraiser will need to turn in their receipt at the host stand or tell your server in order to be counted toward the donation. Gift cards and alcohol purchases do not count towards any donation amount.
- Your organization will receive an email with an initial donation amount. A check will be issued in 45 days from the event.

Poblano Grill DINE FOR DOLLARS Rules:

- Dates must be requested at least three weeks in advance. Due to limited availability, schedule as much as three months in advance. See link on Poblanogrill.net for registration form. Confirmation email is required.
- The organization must provide a copy of their W9 form which verifies their EIN (or Federal Tax Identification Number).
- Any donation check for the organization's Dine for Dollars will be mailed solely to the address listed on the W9.
- Group organizer/coordinator must be present on the day of the event.
- All bookings are at the discretion of the manager

Poblano Grill DINE FOR DOLLARS Tips for Success:

Hand Out Flyers –

Hand out flyers to family, friends, neighborhoods, schools & churches – Let people know how excited you are to help raise money for your organization!

Social Media –

Use your social media outlets to get the word out about your donation night! Create an event, tag friends, run a like & share contest to get the word out.

Have Realistic Expectations –

Consider the dollar amount of funds you want to receive from the Dine for Dollars event. For example, if your goal is to earn \$200, at 10%, your organization needs to bring in @\$2,000 in sales. If an average guest spends \$10 at Poblano Grill, then approximately 200 people need to participate in your Dine for Dollars event.
